

COVID-19 Updates and Measures

COVID-19 has changed our lives, the way we work, and how we conduct business. At Coco Cosmetic we consider our clients as part of our extended family and their health and safety are our top priority.

This page serves as a guide on the measures we have implemented and precautions our clients should be taking to control the spread of COVID-19.

DO NOT enter the clinic if...

You have had close contact with anyone with acute respiratory illness or travelled outside of Australia in the past 14 days or have a confirmed case of COVID-19 or had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19

Before your Appointment

While we continue to observe the highest infection control standards, we also have additional COVIDSafe precautions during this time. We appreciate your understanding and co-operation with these safety measures at our practice which include:

- Covid-19 screening of all patients before they attend the rooms
- Mask wearing is required, except as needed for care or examination
- Physical distancing whenever possible
- Patients are asked to use hand sanitiser on entry to the practice
- Regular hand hygiene is practiced by all staff
- Regular cleaning and sanitisation of all areas
- Personal Protective Equipment is used as per health department directions.

COVID 19 PRE-APPOINTMENT SCREENING

Pre-Appointment measures: Patients will be screened prior and asked the following questions as part of pre-screening for treatment, if you answer yes to any of the following questions then an appointment for treatment will be refused.

You have any of the following symptoms:

- fever (<37.8C)
- new onset of cough
- worsening chronic cough
- shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing
- been diagnosed with pneumonia
- sore throat
- difficulty swallowing
- runny nose or nasal congestion (unexplained)
- decrease or loss of sense of smell/taste
- diarrhea, abdominal pain, or nausea/vomiting
- croup
- chills
- headaches
- conjunctivitis (pink eye)
- unexplained fatigue/malaise/muscle aches, delirium, falls, acute functional decline, fast heart rate, low blood pressure, hypoxia, worsening of chronic conditions?

COVID 19 APPOINTMENT MEASURES

1. The practice has implemented a COVIDSafe Plan
2. Only the Nurse and the person receiving treatment is allowed in the treatment room .
3. Social distancing of at least 1.5 m between all persons will be managed constantly.
4. Please use the hand sanitiser on arrival.
5. Your temperature will be checked on arrival. If you have a fever, you will not be able to have treatment.
6. An additional 15 minutes should be given between every appointment to allow for all areas to be sanitised.
7. All staff having physical contact with a patients will wear correct PPE.

8. No more than 1 patients seated at minimum of 4 sqm apart shall be in the waiting area.

COVID vaccine and treatment timing

We are glad the community is gradually following public health advice to get vaccinated to combat this virus:

. There is no need to defer Antiwrinkle treatments if you are receiving your Covid vaccine.

.To exercise caution we encourage you to defer treatment if any symptoms develop after vaccination.

Tissue Fillers appear to have a small risk profile post vaccination however we recommend an interval of at least 2 weeks before and 2 weeks after each COVID vaccination dose.
